What about a pleasant stay in Chambéry to discover this beautiful city and taste the local specialities ?

Chambéry is a city on the move which has managed to keep a human dimension and a high quality of life. It's also a city steeped in history. You will enjoy exploring the old town with its back streets and its townhouses, the Dukes' castle, the Gothic Sainte-Chapelle tower and its 70-bell chime, one of the largest in the world (*there are concerts on the 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month at 5.30 pm*).

Concerning the museums, three of them are well worth the visit : the Savoy Museum, the Fine Arts Museum and the Charmettes (Jean-Jacques Rousseau's House).

In the old town, you can do some shopping in a peaceful and quiet atmosphere and find many shops at reasonable prices.

Chambéry is the ideal gateway to start from if you'd like to tour round Savoy. It's near the largest ski resorts in Europe, close to lake Bourget, the biggest natural lake in France, lake Aiguebelette, the most extensive vineyards of Savoy, the Bauges and Chartreuse Natural Parks and not far from the Vanoise National Park, the first one created in France.

Believe me, you will be under the spell of Chambéry !
